

## Irish Students Complete Work Term Placements in Canada

Thirteen food science students from Cork Institute of Technology (CIT) completed work term placements in St. John's, Newfoundland and Labrador during the summers of 2009 and 2010. Students were placed at a number of companies in the city, with three of those students conducting research at Memorial University of Newfoundland.

Two students from CIT also completed work terms at Dalhousie University in Halifax, Nova Scotia.

The Food Link programme was funded under EU-Canada programme which promotes mutual understanding between the people of the European Union and Canada including broader knowledge of their languages, cultures and institutions.
