

Student exchange between Dalhousie University and the EU

A number of students completed semesters of their university programs through the Food Link mobility project.

Dalhousie University hosted a student from the University of Nottingham in 2009, and in 2010 hosted 2 students from the University of Nottingham and 3 students from the University of Copenhagen.

Two students from Dalhousie University travelled to the EU for the fall 2010 semester, with one student studying at CIT and another studying at the University of Copenhagen.

The Food Link programme was funded under EU-Canada programme which promotes mutual understanding between the people of the European Union and Canada including broader knowledge of their languages, cultures and institutions.
